In this two-hour gathering – we will hear American Sikh Civil Rights Activist, filmmaker, and author, Valarie Kaur, share her story of how, “in this time of enormous rage when the fires are burning all around us,” she has come to hear Revolutionary Love as the call of our times – and a force for social justice. Kaur defines Revolutionary Love as “the choice to enter into labor for others who do not look like us, for our opponents who hurt us, and for ourselves.”

After watching Valarie’s powerful video presentation, we will break into small groups to share our stories with one another, and discuss how Valarie’s ideas about Revolutionary Love might inform our own individual spiritual walk, and the mission and purpose of our ministries




## Friday Evening, March 19

### Second Wave Spirituality with Chris Saade

Chris Saade is an author, life coach, and psychological and spiritual teacher. In his inspiring book *Second Wave Spirituality* he states, "you and I are part of one of the greatest evolutionary leaps of consciousness. We are witnessing love erupting into global action. We are participating in a worldwide movement of engaged spirituality. What is required from us is the courage to open our hearts, unleash our love, expand our imagination, and uphold justice in the circles of our life. The emerging wave of engaged spirituality that we are witnessing is a grassroots phenomenon. Each one of us is essential to its maturation and realization."

Born in Beirut, Lebanon to a Christian family, he was involved in peace and humanitarian work for 14 years before and during the Lebanese war. Experiencing the devastation of war firsthand broke his heart and impelled his love for freedom and peace. During this very sad time of collective suffering, he continued his peacemaking work. He is the author of *Second Wave Spirituality: Passion for Peace, Passion for Justice*; and *Prayers for Peace and Justice*; as well as *Prayers from the Heart*.



## Saturday Afternoon, March 20

### See No Stranger—A Memoir and Manifesto of Revolutionary Love by Valarie Kaur

Valarie Kaur is a seasoned civil rights activist and celebrated prophetic voice “at the forefront of progressive change” (Center for American Progress). Valarie burst into American consciousness in the wake of the 2016 election when her Watch Night Service address went viral with 30+ million views worldwide. Her question “Is this the darkness of the tomb – or the darkness of the womb?” reframed the political moment and became a mantra for people fighting for change. Valarie now leads the Revolutionary Love Project to reclaim love as a force for justice in America. As a lawyer, filmmaker, and innovator, she has won policy change on multiple fronts – hate crimes, racial profiling, immigration detention, solitary confinement, Internet freedom, and more. She founded Groundswell Movement, Faithful Internet, and the Yale Visual Law Project to inspire and equip new generations of advocates. Valarie has been a regular TV commentator on MSNBC and contributor to CNN, NPR, PBS, the Hill, Huffington Post, and the Washington Post. A daughter of Sikh farmers in California’s heartland, Valarie earned degrees at Stanford University, Harvard Divinity School, and Yale Law School. Valarie’s book, *SEE NO STRANGER: A Memoir & Manifesto of Revolutionary Love*, was released in 2020 and expands on her “blockbuster” TED Talk.
